SCOPE & POTENTIAL

- Indian water market is \$ 30 billion sized.
- 80 % of India's surface water is polluted.
- Only 31 % of urban wastewater is treated per day.
- Maharashtra is emerging as the water sector capital.
- India is the 7th largest producer of hydroelectric power.
- CAGR of 19.5 % is the capital expenditure on water reuse.
- Only 70% of class I urban population has some sewerage facility.
- More than 53 % of Indian homes - about 70 % in the villages lack toilets.
- The total wastewater generated by the 299 class I cities is 16,662 MLD daily.
- Only 37 % of urban sewage is treated per day at 23,277 million litres per day (MLD)
- The Union Government has allocated US \$ 3 billion for the Clean Ganga programme.
- By 2018, over 1,00,000 solar PV water pumping systems are targeted to be installed.
- Water recycling rate is less than 20 % and so water reuse market holds huge opportunity.
- Global rainwater harvesting market will witness a CAGR of 4.8% during the period 2016-2020.
- Kuwait, Israel, Singapore and Egypt are leading with 91%, 85%, 35% and 32% of wastewater reuse.
- India's per capita water storage capacity currently is much below that of China or the United States
- India's total water and wastewater treatment market is US \$ 420 million & growing at 18 % annually.
- 75 % of water pollution is from domestic sewage, which is discharged untreated into local water bodies.
- More than 60 % of India's irrigated agriculture and 85 % of drinking water supplies are dependent on groundwater.
- The Central Government allocated Rs 12,517 crore (US \$1.86 billion) to the Ministry of Water Resources in FY 2016-17.
- Over 70 Government Ministries/Departments earmarked nearly Rs 16.5 thousand crores for cleanliness programmes'18-19.
- Central Pollution Control Board - Hazardous waste generation in 2015 was 7.46 million metric tonnes from 44,000 industries.
- Rs 15,260 crore (US \$2.77 billion) has been allocated to the Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation to expand & improve water.
- Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP) proposes to raise the required Rs 86,500 crore through budgetary resources...
